## HOW CAN FERC RELICENSING POSITIVELY IMPACT THE RIVER?

- It can require restoration of fish and wildlife habitat and improved instream flows.
- If you're a whitewater boater, it can require a safe takeout at Ward's Ferry, which is currently dangerous and unsafe to recreationists.
- It can also have negative impacts on the river, if we don't act now.
- If you want to improve the long-term health of the Tuolumne River, please submit a comment to FERC regarding the relicensing of Don Pedro Dam. The FERC comment period closes on April 12th, 2018. Don't miss this once-in-a-lifetime opportunity!

## HOW TO SUBMIT A COMMENT

- 1 Go To:  
Go to <https://ferc.gov/docs-filing/ecomment.asp>
- 2 Click on the orange eComment box
- 3 Fill out your personal information  
Click "Submit". This will prompt an email to be sent to you.
- 4 Check your email  
Click on the link provided to finish the comment submission process.
- 5 Enter Docket Number

Click blue plus sign (far right of page) to add it to your "selected docket" list
- 6 Visit our "FERC Facts" page  
There you will find suggested comments, talking points, and updates as you write your comments.
- 7 Click submit  
Then verify you've received an email confirmation.
